ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PACIFIC NORTHWEST ASSOCIATION OF INVESTIGATORS,

INC.

The undersigned incorporators hereby make and subscribe these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to Remington's Revised Statutes, Sec. 3888, et seq., relating to the formation of Corporations not formed for Profit, and for the objects which are hereinafter set forth:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be PACIFIC NORTHWEST ASSOCIATION OF INVESTIGATORS, INC., and said corporation shall be located at 211 Lyon Building, in the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington, with the chief place of business of such corporation at the above named address in said city, state and county.

ARTICLE II.

This corporation shall not be a joint stock company. The terms for admission to membership shall be as follows: Any person, firm or corporation engaged in the profession of investigator for a period of at least three years, or any officer of any firm or corporation so engaged may become a member of the association, upon filing an application for such membership with the Secretary of the association and upon furnishing said association with proof of compliance with the terms and conditions required of members by the by-laws of said association in force and in effect at the time said application is submitted and subject to the approval of the existing membership, in accordance with said by-laws.

ARTICLE III.

2 The objects for which this corporation is formed are as
3 follows:


4 To establish a "Code of Ethics" and to seek its adoption
5 by all licensed persons in the field of private investigation in
6 this State and in the Pacific Northwest area, to consider proposed
7 legislation or to propose legislation which will aid in securing
8 for the public affected, services by private investigators in accor-
9 dance with said "Code of Ethics" and to aid and assist the members
10 hereof by all means available to it to furnish the public in this
11 area with the highest standard possible in our profession.

12 To do all things and exercise all rights and powers incident
13 to corporations organized under the aforementioned statutes; includ-
14 ing, but without limiting, that which is permitted by Sec. 3894 of
15 Remington's Revised Statutes, that is to acquire, mortgage and sell
16 property, personal and real, for the purpose of carrying out the
17 objects of this corporation, and to do all acts permitted by law
18 to effectuate these purposes and objects.

ARTICLE IV.

20
21 The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its
22 officers and board of directors, who were elected in accordance with
23 the by-laws heretofore adopted by the voluntary association bearing
24 the same name on September 25, 1947; and they shall serve as the
25 first directors of this corporation until May 1, 1948, at which time
26 the first annual meeting of the corporation shall be held and their
27 successors shall be elected in accordance with the by-laws of the
28 corporation then in force and effect.


